- HOW Old Northern Road from Castle Hill to Wisemans Ferry
Cross the River on the WEBBS CREEK FERRY. Turn left
into Webbs Creek Road, and drive 5kl to CASTLE
MOUNTAIN. Follow the Signs.
- PARKING Please follow the signs and park where marked.
- COST \$85.00 per head. Pre-school children free. No
reduction for other children.
- Cost Break-down. \$70.00 per head to Castle Mountain.
\$15.00 balance to cover postage, stationery,
printing, phone, prizes, targets, banquet expenses
