INFORMATION:

Good Friday takes place on 5th April 1985. The Convention opens at 10am on Saturday 6th & closes with lunch on Tuesday 9th.

TRANSPORT:

Train times will be published in the March '85 issue of NEW HEDEBY. These trains leave from SPENCER ST STATION in Melbourne & will travel to CASTLEMAINE STATION (15km from Maldon). All trains arriving at Castlemaine on Good Friday will be met & transport provided to the Convention site.

Special arrangements for interstate & overseas conventioners can be made if we are given sufficient notice.

ACCOMMODATION:

Everyone will be "sleeping out"! So bring your own sleeping gear - sleeping bags &c. and tents or similar shelter.

For those who can't carry much gear (coming by 'plane) some accommodation can be arranged, but not sleeping gear. Let us know in advance if you need this to be provided, so that we can make

arrangements (whether you will be coming singularly, as couples, groups &c, and how many. This will be fairly limited, so please keep it for people who really need it).

Showers with hot & cold running water will be on site.

FOOD:

Tea will be provided for on Good Friday evening, & every meal from then on until lunch on Tuesday (this is all included in the convention fee). Dinner will be provided on Tuesday for those who can stay to help clean up and dismantle the site.

Cutlery & crockery will be provided, though a dagger for spearing your food with is more in keeping if you have one. Let us know if you are a vegetarian.
